**HISTORY OF EMPLOYMENT AT PROCTOR HOSPITAL, INC.  
NOVEMBER 1979 – AUGUST 2009 (MEDICALLY INDUCED RETIREMENT )**

Started employment at Proctor Hospital's Chemical Dependency Center (Illinois Institute for Addiction Recovery/IIAR) in November 1979 as a Counselor Intern/Trainee in their Counselor Training Program (one calendar year). Was an inpatient and outpatient Counselor from November 1980 to May 1987. Was responsible for a caseload of Adult and Adolescent inpatient and outpatient patients/clients in a modified Hazelden Model Program (treated all addictions & mental illness secondary to substance dependence).

Throughout employment at Proctor Hospital provided: family interventions as needed; provided employee assistance services; external prevention services; participated as a staff member in the Family Program.

From May 1987 to August 2009 was a member of the IIAR Management Team in the following positions: Adult Unit Coordinator, May 1987 to December 1990; Coordinator of Inpatient Services, December 1990 to March 1992; Coordinator of Clinical Services, March 1992 to December 1995; Manager of Illinois Institute for Addiction Recovery at Proctor Hospital, December 1995 to June 1999; Manager of Illinois Institute for Addiction Recovery at Proctor Hospital & BroMenn Regional Medical Center, June 1999 to January 2002; Administrative Director of Illinois Institute for Addiction Recovery (Department Head of Proctor Hospital ) January 2002 to August 2009 (retired).

Beginning with the position of Manager of IIAR @ Proctor, December 1995 to date of Retirement, was responsible for providing Administrative Supervision for all IIAR employees and consultants. This included Nurses, Psychiatrists, Psychologists and Co-Medical Directors.

While employed at Proctor Hospital IIAR accomplished the following: developed and implemented the IIAR's first Saturday Family Program; was a member of and was a co-chair of Proctor Hospital's Ethics Committee; developed, implemented and coordinated a training program for Family Practice Residents; developed, implemented and coordinated a Master's Level Internship for MSW candidates from University of Illinois.; co-developed and co-facilitated Intensive Codependency Treatment Program; responsible for preparing and successfully passing multiple JCAHO and State of Illinois licensure surveys; developed and implemented IIAR's Process Addiction treatment program; developed and implemented IIAR's Process Addiction consultation program; developed Process Addiction's Assessment Tools; developed and implemented IIAR's Chronic Pain and Addiction Program; developed and implemented IIAR's initial Relapse Prevention Program developed the Family Meeting Approach to Intervention; became a National and International trainer on topics of AODA & Process Addiction Prevention, Intervention and Treatment; co-authored the model for the Board Registered Interventionist credential; while on the IIAR Management Team the IIAR expanded from one program to four programs; developed and implemented a 21 and 30 hour Gambling counselor Training Program.

From August 1978 to November 1979, Program Coordinator of Peoria Illinois Community Action Agency's Alcoholic Rehabilitation Center.
